

## **Reducing Social Isolation among Older Adults**

The National Center for Mobility Management (NCMM), a technical assistance center funded by the Federal Transit Administration, is interested in case studies on collaborations among the transportation, aging services, and public health sectors on this issue:

**Issue:** The role of transportation in reducing social isolation among older adults, leading to improved physical and mental health outcomes for this population.

NCMM is seeking to establish a contract with a nonprofit or for-profit organization eligible to receive federal funds to write up a detailed case study on a local, regional, or state cross-sector collaboration addressing this issue. The applicant should have been involved or be familiar with such a collaboration and be able to provide a detailed report of the project and its outcomes.

NCMM will fund case study write-ups from no more than 3 communities. Each organization applying will be responsible for writing up only one case study.

Please submit a brief proposal that responds to the following points:

- 1. Name of the organization submitting the letter.
- 2. A clear indication that the organization is eligible to receive federal funds and is registered in, or willing to become registered in, the <a href="System of Award Management (SAM) system">System</a>.
- 3. Name and title of individual submitting the Letter of Interest.
- 4. Name and title of individuals who will lead and work on the project, and a short statement of relevant experience.
- 5. Brief description (max 250 words) of the collaboration that the organization is proposing to write up.
- 6. Description (max 250 words) of the organization's participation in or knowledge of the collaboration.
- 7. A statement that the organization has the capacity to complete the work by June 30, 2022.
- 8. A proposed budget for completing the write up of the case study.

The work must be completed by June 30, 2022.
