- United Way of Central Oklahoma Community Needs Assessment identifies transportation as a barrier
- Transportation Innovation Grant: 4 years & \$1 million
- March 28, 2019: CTAA in partnership with EMBARK & OTA are chosen as grant recipients



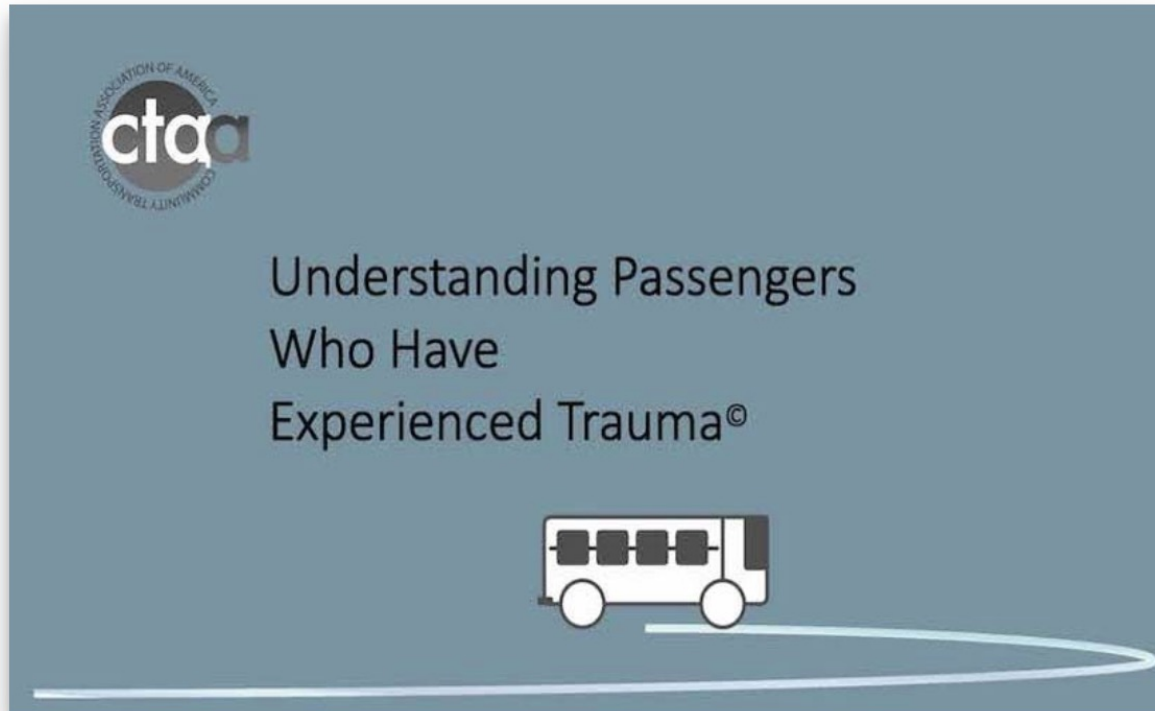
# What is the Climb Ride Program?

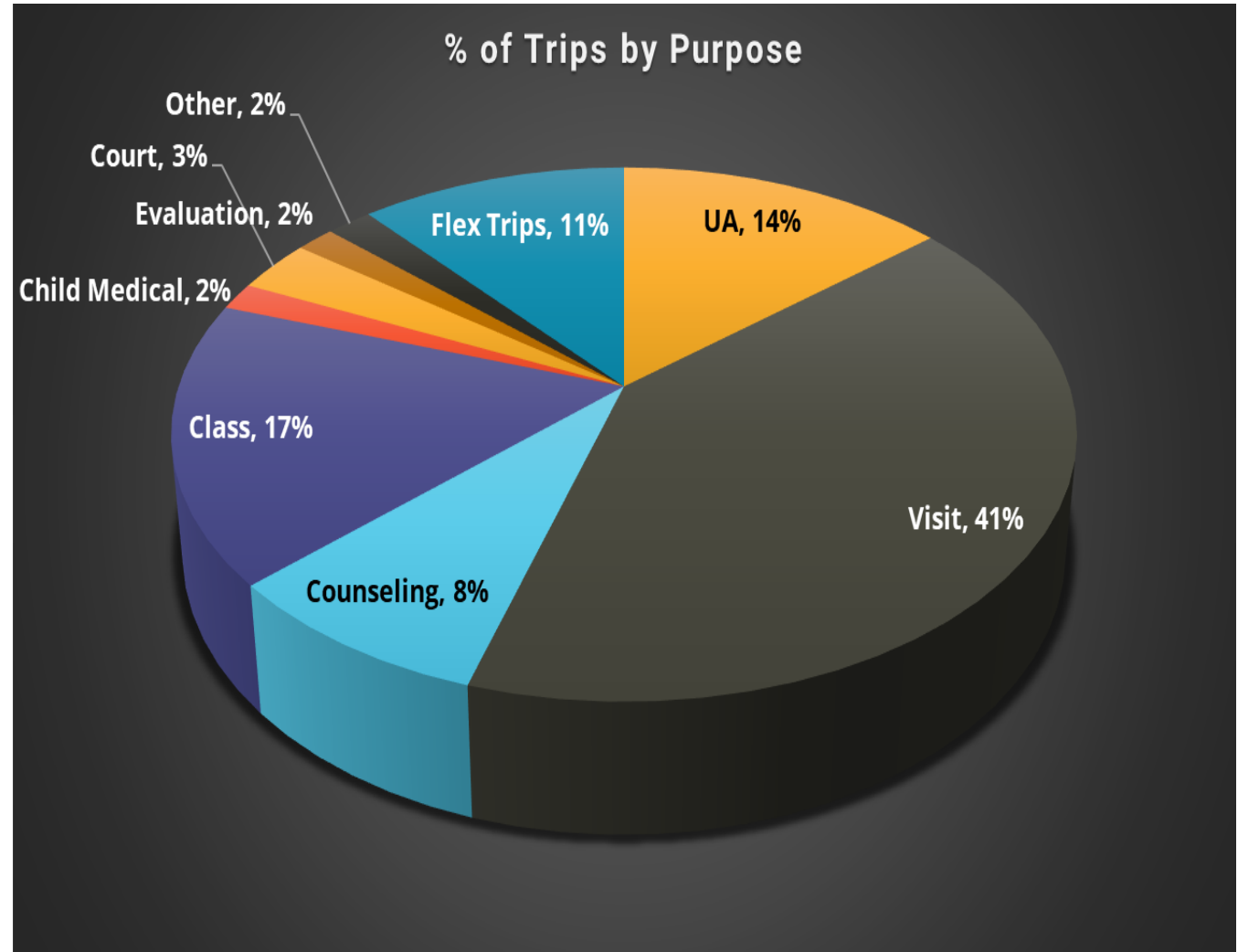
